#### INSTRUCTIONS OF CANDIDATES

1. Convocation for conferring degrees shall ordinarily be held in the month notified in the website/dailies by the university
2. The candidates intending to receive their degrees/diplomas at this convocation either 'In-Person or In-Absentia' should submit their application through online at [www.tanuv.ac.in](http://www.tanuv.ac.in) or [www2.tanuv.ac.in](http://www2.tanuv.ac.in) from **30.07.2019, 10.00 AM to 14.08.2019, 6.00 PM.**
3. Candidates should carefully read the instructions before filling up the application form online. All fields in the online application should be correctly and completely filled in.
4. After filling in all the relevant columns in the application, the candidates may recheck the details provided by them before submission through PREVIEW.
5. The application fee for the receipt of degree / diplomas is;  
APPLICANT FROM INDIA      *IN PERSON*      : Rs.1000/-      *IN ABSENTIA*      : Rs.1500/-  
APPLICANT FROM ABROAD      *IN PERSON*      : 20 USD      *IN ABSENTIA*      : 25 USD  
Candidates should ensure the correct amount of ONLINE APPLICATION FEE for IN PERSON / IN ABSENTIA should be paid by using the methods *viz.*, Credit Card, Debit Card, Internet Banking in the ONLINE PAYMENT GATEWAY.
6. **PAYMENT BY ANY OTHER MODE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**  
After the successful online payment of prescribed fee and submission of application, the candidate will receive an SMS and email stating that his/her application is submitted successfully with a mention of their Login ID and Password. There is no need to send hard copy of the application.  
No addition, deletion or alteration of any particulars relating to the application is permitted after the submission of the online application.
7. Applications not filled properly or defective / incomplete particulars or received after the prescribed date shall not be accepted.
8. **Candidates who have applied for PG Diploma (Distance Mode) will be conferred only through "In absentia" mode.**
9. Candidates who have applied in person and not turned up/not applied can get their Degrees/ Diplomas on payment of necessary prescribed fee.
10. The eligible graduands can download their convocation call letter from the University website from seven days before the date of Convocation and they can receive their admit card at the convocation venue 3 hours before the scheduled time of convocation.
11. The candidates shall wear white trousers, dark coloured coat, shirt with stiff collar and tie and academic robe as detailed below for the Convocation. Candidates not wearing the costume prescribed above will not be admitted to the Convocation. Women candidates shall wear the Indian dress of choice and the same academic robe as men prescribed for that purpose.

- 12 Candidates must be present for the Convocation in their respective academic robes. The Gowns and Hoods prescribed are as follows:

For MSc (Bio-Technology)	A gown made of Golden Yellow silk or stuff cut like that of Cambridge M.A. gown
For MTech (FT)	A gown made of Golden Yellow silk or stuff cut like that of Cambridge M.A. gown
For B.V.Sc. & A.H	A gown made of Golden yellow silk or stuff cut like that of Cambridge B.A. gown
For BTech (FT)	A gown made of Golden yellow silk or stuff cut like that of Cambridge B.A. gown.
For BTech (PT)	A gown made of Golden yellow silk or stuff cut like that of Cambridge B.A. gown
For BTech (DT)	A gown made of Golden yellow silk or stuff cut like that of Cambridge B.A. gown
For PG Diploma Regular Mode	A gown made of Golden yellow silk or stuff cut like that of Cambridge B.A. gown

### **HOODS**

For Ph.D.	A hood made of white silk or stuff lined with maroon silk or stuff
For Ph.D.(Food Technology)	A hood made of white silk or stuff lined with purple silk or stuff
For MVSc	A hood made of white silk or stuff
For MSc (Bio-Technology)	A hood made of Golden yellow silk or stuff edged with Dark Blue
For MTech (FT)	A hood made of Golden yellow silk or stuff edged with pink
For BVSc & AH	A hood made of Golden yellow silk or stuff edged with maroon
For BTech (FT)	A hood made of Golden yellow silk or stuff edged with green
For BTech (PT)	A hood made of Golden yellow silk or stuff edged with red
For BTech (DT)	A hood made of Golden yellow silk or stuff edged with white
For PG Diploma Regular Mode	A hood made of Golden yellow silk or stuff edged with Dark Green
