INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1. Convocation for conferring degrees shall ordinarily be held in the month notified in the website/ dailies by the university
2. The candidates intending to receive their degrees/diplomas at this convocation either 'In-Person or In-Absentia should submit their application through online at www.tanuv.ac.in or www2.tanuv.ac.in/convocation from **15.10.2018, 10.00AM to 16.11.2018, 6.00 PM**. After submitting the **online application and online payment**, the candidate should take the printout of filled in online application form, attach the photocopy of Provisional Degree Certificate and send to the Registrar, TANUVAS, Madhavaram Milk Colony, Chennai – 600 051, so as to reach on or before **26.11.2018, 5.45 P.M.**
3. Candidates should carefully read the instructions before filling up the application form online. All fields in the online application should be correctly and completely filled in.
4. After filling in all the relevant columns in the application, the candidates may recheck the details provided by them before submission through PREVIEW.
5. The application fee for the receipt of degree / diplomas is;
APPLICANT FROM INDIA *IN PERSON* : Rs.1000/- *IN ABSENTIA* : Rs.1500/-
APPLICANT FROM ABROAD *IN PERSON* : 20 USD *IN ABSENTIA* : 25 USD
Candidates should ensure the correct amount of ONLINE APPLICATION FEE for IN PERSON / IN ABSENTIA should be paid by using the methods *viz.*, Credit Card, Debit Card, Internet Banking in the ONLINE PAYMENT GATEWAY.
6. **PAYMENT BY ANY OTHER MODE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
After the successful online payment of prescribed fee and submission of application, the candidate will receive an SMS and email stating that his/her application is submitted successfully with a mention of their Login ID and Password.
No addition, deletion or alteration of any particulars relating to the application is permitted after the submission of the online application.
7. **AFTER SUBMITTING THE APPLICATION ONLINE, THE CANDIDATES SHOULD TAKE THE PRINT OUT OF ONLINE FILLED APPLICATION, DULY SIGN, ATTACH PROVISIONAL DEGREE CERTIFICATE AND SEND TO THE REGISTRAR, TAMIL NADU VETERINARY AND ANIMAL SCIENCES UNIVERSITY, MADHAVARAM MILK COLONY, CHENNAI – 600 051 ON OR BEFORE 26.11.2018, 5.45 P.M.**

- Application received after the prescribed due date and time will not be considered on any account. The University will not take any responsibility for postal delays. The candidates are therefore advised to submit their applications online and send their application hard copy sufficiently early before the prescribed due dates.
8. Applications not filled properly or defective / incomplete particulars or received after the prescribed date shall not be accepted.
 9. Enquiries from the candidates about receipt of their applications in the Office will not receive attention. Candidates are advised as a safeguard against miscarriage or non-delivery of applications, to submit the same much earlier than the prescribed date.
 10. **Candidates who have applied for PG Diploma (Distance Mode) will be conferred only through "In absentia" mode.**
 11. Candidates who have applied in person and not turned up/not applied can get their Degrees/ Diplomas on payment of necessary prescribed fee.
 12. The eligible graduands can download their convocation call letter from the University website from seven days before the date of Convocation and they can receive their admit card at the convocation venue 3 hours before the scheduled time of convocation.
 13. The candidates shall wear white trousers, dark coloured coat, shirt with stiff collar and tie and academic robe as detailed below for the Convocation. Candidates not wearing the costume prescribed above will not be admitted to the Convocation. Women candidates shall wear the Indian dress of choice and the same academic robe as men prescribed for that purpose.
 14. Candidates must be present for the Convocation in their respective academic robes. The Gowns and Hoods prescribed are as follows:

For PhD (Food Technology)	A gown made of White silk or stuff cut like that of Cambridge M.A.gown
For MPhil	A gown made of Golden yellow silk or stuff cut like that of Cambridge M.A. Gown
For M.V.Sc.	A gown made of Golden yellow silk or stuff cut like that of Cambridge M.A. gown
For MSc (Bio-informatics)	A gown made of Golden Yellow silk or stuff cut like that of Cambridge M.A. gown
For Mtech (FT)	A gown made of Golden Yellow silk or stuff cut like that of Cambridge M.A. gown
For B.V.Sc. & A.H	A gown made of Golden yellow silk or stuff cut like that of Cambridge B.A. gown
For BTech (FT)	A gown made of Golden yellow silk or stuff cut like that of Cambridge B.A. gown.
For BTech (PT)	A gown made of Golden yellow silk or stuff cut like that of Cambridge B.A. gown.

HOODS

For Ph.D.	A hood made of white silk or stuff lined with maroon silk or stuff
For Ph.D.	A hood made of white silk or stuff lined with purple silk or stuff
For MPhil	A hood made of Golden yellow silk or stuff edged with maroon
For MVSc	A hood made of white silk or stuff.
For MSc (Bio-Informatics)	A hood made of Golden yellow silk or stuff edged with Turquoise blue
For MTech (FT)	A hood made of Golden yellow silk or stuff edged with pink
For BVSc & AH	A hood made of Golden yellow silk or stuff edged with maroon
For BTech (FT)	A hood made of Golden yellow silk or stuff edged with green
For BTech (PT)	A hood made of Golden yellow silk or stuff edged with red
