**GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION OF STUDENTS UNDER PAYMENT SEATS
(UNFILLED SEATS OF NRI QUOTA)**

1. Course and Number of seats available for the year 2009-2010

B.V.Sc. & A.H.	-	1 seat
B.F.Sc.	-	1 seat

1.1. Duration of the course

B.V.Sc. & A.H.	-	5 years (10 semesters)
B.F.Sc.	-	4 years (8 semesters)

2. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

2.1. Application form

Separate application form should be used for applying to B.V.Sc. & A.H. and B.F.Sc. degree courses. The application form can be downloaded from the website www.tanuvac.ac.in

2.2. Eligibility and Academic Qualifications

Applicant must be Indian National.

Candidates must have completed 12 years (10+2) of school education of Indian system i.e. HSC/CBSE/ISC or its equivalent.

Candidates must have passed with good marks / grades as per their system of education in Biology or Botany and Zoology, Physics and Chemistry in 11th and 12th year of School Education.

2.3. Age Limit

Candidates should not have completed 21 years as on 01-07-2009.

2.4. Registration fee

A Bank Draft drawn in favour of "The Finance Officer, TANUVAS, Chennai" for a value of Indian Rupees 500 (Rupees five hundred only) payable at Chennai from any Nationalized Bank of India should be submitted along with the application.

2.5. Receipt of filled in application

Application complete in all respects should reach “**The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Madhavaram Milk Colony, Chennai 600 051, Tamil Nadu, India**” on or before **27th August 2009**.

Applications received after due date will not be considered under any circumstances.

If any of the required certificates is not enclosed, the application is liable for rejection summarily. Enclosures not received along with application will not be accepted later.

2.6. Selection of candidates

Selection of the candidates will be done based on Academic Merit. The selection list will be hosted in the University website: www.tanuvvas.ac.in

In case of tie in the common merit list, the inter-se-merit among such students will be determined in the order of priority as specified below:

- ❖ Percentage of marks obtained in Biology (or) Zoology and Botany taken together.
- ❖ Percentage of marks in Chemistry
- ❖ Percentage of marks in Physics
- ❖ Date of birth: seniority in age will be given preference

2.7. Attested copies to be enclosed along with the application form

1. Transfer Certificate / Migration Certificate
2. HSC / CBSE / ISC / Equivalent Examination mark sheet(s)
3. Proof for Date of Birth
4. Proof for Indian National

2.8. Payment of fee

On receipt of allotment order, the candidate has to pay the prescribed fee immediately in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of “**The Finance Officer, TANUVAS, Chennai**” payable at **Chennai**.

2.8.1. Fees

Note: For each extended year of study, an additional fee of Indian Rupee equivalent to US \$ 1000 per annum will be charged.

2.8.2. Development charge

Indian Rupee equivalent to **US \$ 500** shall be paid at the time of admission.

2.8.3. Fees once paid is not refundable

2.8.4. Other fees:

Special fees, examination fees, boarding and lodging fees etc., should be paid in Indian rupee at the time of admission / as and when required as per the rules of the University.

3. GENERAL INFORMATION

3.1. Hostel Accommodation

Limited hostel accommodation is available inside the campus. Interested candidates may apply to the Dean of the campus for Hostel accommodation. They have to pay the prescribed fee as per Hostel Rules. The hostel mess is run on dividing system.

3.2. All admissions shall be deemed as provisional and subject to further scrutiny. They shall be liable to cancellation at any stage during the study if it is found that an admission was contrary to the rules or invalid by reason of incorrect or false information furnished by the applicants or their parents/guardians at the time of admission. Any cancellation of admission shall not exclude penal action under the relevant criminal law.

3.3. It shall be the discretion of the University to allot B.V.Sc. & A.H. candidates to any of the two colleges.

3.4. Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University reserves the right to cancel or vary any of these rules without notice.

4. PREVENTION OF RAGGING

University is taking stringent measures to prevent ragging in the University campuses and Hostels. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the University authority, the concerned student(s) shall be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel such student(s) from the institution.
