Veterinary College and Research Institute, Namakkal, was started on 14.06.1985 as a constituent college of Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University. It has entered the twenty fifth year of its existence in 2009-10. This is a significant milestone in the annals of the institute and to commemorate this landmark, the Department of Veterinary Parasitology is organising a **National Seminar on "Integrated Management of Arthropod Pests of Livestock and Poultry in the aftermath of Global Warming and Climate Change"** at Veterinary College and Research Institute, Namakkal on **21st and 22nd April, 2010.**

Poultry and Livestock industry continues to be plagued by numerous arthropod pests and one of the biggest problem that face the industry is fly control. Arthropod pests of livestock and poultry cause serious economic losses in the form of decreased milk / egg / meat production, inefficient feed conversion, damaged hides and transmissions of pathogens that cause mortality and morbidity. Flies in large numbers cause annoyance and nuisance besides transmitting pathogens. Nuisance issues are further complicated by the development of resistance in pest that reduce the available chemical control options to few compounds. Pests related issues are further amplified by the expanding suburban development into once rural communities. It is essential for the industry, veterinarians and scientists to work together to solve arthropod pest problems. This seminar arose from the need for regional cooperation on the management of pests responsible for economic losses in an industry beset with narrow profit margins and increasing production costs.
