- ❖ The analysed data is collected computerized and used to prepare the weather forecast in short and medium range and host them in IMD *Agromet* and Agromet website, Mksian farmer portal and University website bi-weekly.
- ❖ The daily observation is to be uploaded in the IMD agrimet website and download the other data.
- ❖ To assist the Nodal officer and Technical Officer for preparation of various reports in the GKMS Scheme and other activities related to the scheme.
- ❖ The agromet observer is responsible for the neat maintenance of the observatory.
- ❖ The Observer should regularly have to take a tour upon the instruction of Nodal Officer in the covered district to collect data among the beneficiary and observe the impact.
