2. No TA / DA will be paid for the candidates attending written exam and interview. Candidates have to make their own arrangements for their stay at Chennai.
3. Mere attending of the interview does not guarantee them the appointment and the selection will be based purely on merit. Candidates are requested to produce all original certificates (UG / PG degrees, age proof, experience certificate, publications and any other testimonials that certify their competency to work in the project) at the time of interview.
4. Selection will be made as per the norms of ASRR, TANUVAS.
5. The appointment is purely on temporary basis to work for the scheme **“Role of TLR2 in molecular pathogenesis of cryptosporidiosis: a clue for novel anti-apicomplexan therapeutics”**.
6. The job will be terminated at the time of closure of the scheme.

9. Application may be submitted by email/by post to the address given below on or before 25th November 2018 or on the day of walk-in-interview before 10.00 am.

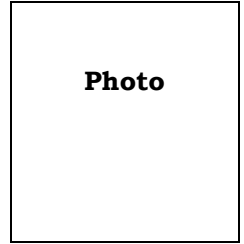
