ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (TANUVAS), the first of its kind in Asia was established on 20th September 1989 with headquarters at Chennai. The mandates of the University are to impart education, to ensure advancement of learning and prosecution of research and to undertake extension to rural people in cooperation with the government departments in different branches of Veterinary and Animal Sciences. TANUVAS has been conferred with the most prestigious "Sardar Patel Outstanding ICAR Institution Award - 2011", in recognition of its meritorious performance in education, research and extension in the country in the field of Veterinary, Animal and Fisheries Sciences at the 84th Foundation Day of the ICAR.



Veterinary College and Research Institute, Orathanadu, located in Thanjavur district of Tamil Nadu is the constituent college of TANUVAS sprawling around 206 acres and was started during 2011-12. The college offers undergraduate and post graduate

programmes in Veterinary and Animal Sciences and also offers post graduate diploma courses through distance mode.

Thanjavur District is the Rice Bowl of Tamil Nadu state in the south eastern part of India. The Big Temple and the other famous temples in the district are known all over the world. Thanjavur was the cultural capital of the country in 1790. Thanjavur gained prominence during the period of Chola Kings, who made it as their capital. Thereafter, it was ruled by Nayaks and Maratta Kings, who nurtured art and culture. The cultural, the architectural and the scholarly pursuits of these rulers are reflected in the great monuments like Grand Anaicut, Big Temple and Saraswathi Mahal Library etc. in the district. Kumbakonam, known as town of temples of Tamil Nadu is also located in Thanjavur district. Kumbakonam emerged as an important centre of education in the late 19th century and was known as the "Cambridge of South India". In July month, Thanjavur district experiences dry climate with maximum day time temperature of 35°C and minimum night time temperature of 20°C.

How to reach Conference Venue

Orathanadu is a town connected by road from Thanjavur city which is well connected by road and rail from Chennai (330 Km), Bengaluru (420 km) and Tiruchirappalli (60 Km). Nearest airports is Tiruchirappalli (TRZ), Madurai (IXM), Chennai (MAA) and Bengaluru (BLR).
